Please keep this in mind when making and canceling bookings for your children. This policy also applies for vacation care bookings, so please keep this in mind as you will still be charged.

Medications: If your child requires medication please ensure that you have provided an action plan as well as the medication (asthma pump, epipen etc.) to the service. It is vital that we have access to your child's medication at our service whilst your child is attending.
